## Unregulated business ventures of utilities (35-A M.R.S. §713)

- 1. A utility may not charge its ratepayers for costs attributable to unregulated business ventures undertaken by the utility or an affiliated.
- 2. The commission shall allocate, between a utility's shareholders and ratepayers, costs for facilities, services or intangibles, including good will or use of a brand name, that are shared between regulated and unregulated business activities.
- 3. The commission shall also attempt to ensure that the utility or any affiliate does not have an unfair advantage in any competitive market as a result of its regulated status or its affiliation with a regulated utility.

## Utility Requirements for Non-Core Activities (Maine PUC Ch. 820)

- 1. A utility must establish a separate corporate entity to offer non-core services.
- 2. When a utility must apportions costs between its core utility service and its non-core services, it must do so in accordance with the FCC fully distributed cost methodology.
- 3. Any assets transferred to an affiliate providing non-core services must be at fair market value.
- 4. Any utility affiliate providing non-core services using the utility's "good will" must compensate the utility the value of which shall be presumed to be the lesser of 1% of the affiliate's total capitalization or 2% of the affiliate's gross revenue for the first six years the affiliate provides non-core services.
- 5. PUC approval is required for a utility to invest more than 5% of the utility's total capitalization in an affiliate providing non-core services.
- 6. Any transfer of customer information to an affiliate must be at FMV and must be made available to all others on the same terms.

## LD 1894 – An Act to Support Municipal Broadband Infrastructure Through Incentives and Competition (35-A M.R.S. § 2111)

- 1. A consumer owned utility that elects to provide broadband service to the public, must first register with the PUC.
- 2. As part of the registration, it must identify a contact person knowledgeable about the utility's broadband service.
- 3. The PUC shall inform the utility of the requirements of Section 713.
