Closing the Broadband Gap

Wireless service is a critical tool in the effort to close the broadband gap

T-Mobile's 5G Network covers 315M Americans, or 95% of the U.S. population. T-Mobile is in the process of a deployment that will offer 99% of the U.S. population access to 5G mobile wireless coverage, including 90% of rural population by 2026.

T-Mobile 5G Home Internet/Internet Freedom – launched in 2021 - over 1M customers. \$50/month flat fee or \$30/month with T-Mobile's wireless family plan. Price is locked in for as long as they're a customer.

- \$10.7B initiative to offer 10M students FREE internet access over 5 years with a T-Mobile hotspot.
- Provides students with a free mobile Wi-Fi hotspot device and 100GB/year for 5 years

 Assurance Wireless – Free Android smartphone, unlimited data, text, calls

 Metro by T-Mobile – ACP \$30 discount applied on variety of plans Prepaid plans range from \$10 plan + 1GB of data to \$35 plan + 12GB of data (all with unlimited text and talk)

T-Mobile Unlimited 55+ Plan – provides discounted pricing for customers over 55.

T-Mobile Magenta Military Plan - offers active-duty military, veterans and their families plans at 50% off regular family-plan pricing

Outreach Efforts

- T-Mobile has partnered with organizations like LULAC (League of United Latin American Citizens), UnidosUS (Latino civil rights organization), and the Human Rights Campaign to sponsor digital literacy programs across the country.
- Digital literacy programs aimed at informing non-internet users about the benefits of a broadband connection will play an important role in driving greater adoption in the near term.
