The Affordable **Connectivity Program**

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service.

This benefit provides a \$30/month discount for your locally owned internet service, powered by Whip City Fiber.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

A household is eligible if one member of the household meets at least one of the criteria below:

- Has an income that is at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Guide lines:
- · Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or Lifeline:
- Is approved to receive benefits under the free and reduced-price school lunch program or the school breakfast program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility
- · Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year.




