Hi George, here are some informal questions/comments, if you want to share with LBNL or post publicly:

- Great and useful analysis overall
- Is there information about Participation levels in the existing rates/programs analyzed? It's great to list the programs, but would be helpful to know how successful they have been.
- Is there information on the Costs associated with ISO-NE market participation? The benefits and revenues are important, but need to weigh against the costs/risks of participation. The FERC 2222 section is helpful, but just more about the implementation and operational costs.
- The report shows current AMI meter penetration, but it is useful to point out that AMI is being installed in MA and RI over the next couple of years that will greatly increase those numbers and potentially enable more options.
